

Call for Entries:

DESERT CORRIDORS

November 16, 2017 - February 7, 2018

Opening Reception: Thursday, November 16, 2017 - 5:30 - 8:00pm

Man-made crossings and waystations, desert washes, and riparian areas are all corridors that offer mammals, reptiles, insects, and birds passage to new habitats over land, by water, and through the air. These corridors become super highways through inhabited and uninhabited terrain. Not found on any road atlas, these routes, hopefully safe and preventing collision, connect creatures of all shapes, sizes and species to new horizons. **DESERT CORRIDORS** begins with what we can see along the path, and continues into the realm of what we can't; bigger ideas of migration and immigration, and concepts of metaphoric consequence that try to answer the age old questions: Where did we come from? Where are we going? And, How do we get there?

Artists are asked to contribute works of art that try to answer these questions and that offer proof of how we move through this world and how the world moves around us. The possibilities are endless. Artists from the region are invited to submit 2-dimensional or 3-dimensional works in any media for consideration in this juried exhibition.

Submission Guidelines

Size/Media

Up to 3 completed works of any size, and in any 2 or 3-dimensional media may be submitted. All work must be ready to display and/or framed for hanging. Any accepted work that is not in keeping with the original submission and/or is not properly prepared for exhibition (following guidelines for matting, framing, and hanging hardware) will not be exhibited. Format

Artists may submit images of work digitally via email (khayes@tohonochul.org) or on a CD to the address below. Artists may submit images of up to 3 artworks in JPEG format (at least 72 dpi, no more than 6 inches in any direction). Each image file should be "renamed" with the artist's last name, first name, title of work, medium, size of the work (in inches), and price. Entries must also contain a list of images that includes the title, date completed, media, dimensions, and price* of each work submitted. Submission materials will not be returned. Do not submit original artwork.



Please include "Attn: DESERT CORRIDORS" in the subject line of the email or on the envelope for mailed submissions.

*All work exhibited at Tohono Chul may be offered for sale. Please indicate the retail price of each submission. Tohono Chul retains 50% of all sales to directly benefit TOHONO CHUL programming, so please factor this into your retail amount. Specify NFS (not for sale) for work that is not for sale.

Artist Information
