ON THE DESERT AN EXPLORATION OF FIBERS

Exhibition Dates: April 25 – July 31, 2019

Woven, torn, pulped, beaten, soaked, stained, dried, drawn, simulated, stitched, painted, printed, turned, found, photographed, felted, braided, knitted, knotted, collaged, carved, burnt, abraded, cast, cut, folded, flocked, hooked, pressed, laced, spun, sewn, etc.

Fiber can be and do so many things. For artists - it is a medium and a process - it is natural and synthetic – it is crafted by hand and industrially machined – it is everywhere and in everything – (like Pima Cotton) it is the fabric of our lives.

ON THE DESERT: An Exploration of Fibers will take to the desert in search of traditional and experimental artworks that are made of, on, and about any and all things fiber while simultaneously exploring (perhaps, redefining) the definition(s) of Fiber Art.

Artists are asked to employ every fiber of their being and contribute art works that are focused on the very fibers they are made with. The possibilities are endless. Artists from the region are invited to submit 2-dimensional or 3-dimensional works in any media for consideration in this curated exhibition.

Submission Guidelines

Size/Media

Up to 3 completed works of any size, and in any 2 or 3-dimensional media may be submitted. If accepted, all work must be ready to display and/or framed for hanging. Any accepted work that is not in keeping with the original submission and/or is not properly prepared for exhibition (following guidelines for matting, framing, and hanging hardware) will not be exhibited. Format

Artists may submit images of work digitally via email (ngeorge@tohonochochul.org) or on a CD to the address below. Artists may submit images of up to 3 artworks in JPEG format (at least 72 dpi, no more than 6 inches in any direction – *if available: 300 dpi, no more than 6 inches in any direction*). Each image file should be “renamed” with the artist’s last name, first name, title of work, medium, size of the work (in inches), and price. Entries must also contain a list of images that includes the title, date completed, media, dimensions, and price* of each work submitted. Submission materials will not be returned. Do not submit original artwork.

Please include "Attn: ON THE DESERT" in the subject line of the email or on the envelope for mailed submissions.

**All work exhibited at Tohono Chul may be offered for sale. Please indicate the retail price of each submission. Tohono Chul retains 50% of all sales to directly benefit TOHONO CHUL programming, so please factor this into your retail amount. Specify NFS (not for sale) for work that is not for sale.*

Artist Information

Submitting artists must include a brief artist statement about the submitted work and an artist biography with complete contact information. ___Image list with the title, date completed, media, dimensions, and price of each submitted work (submitted in either a Word document or pasted in the body of the submission email).

___Artist contact information, biography and brief statement about the submitted work (submitted in either a Word document or pasted in the body of the submission email).
